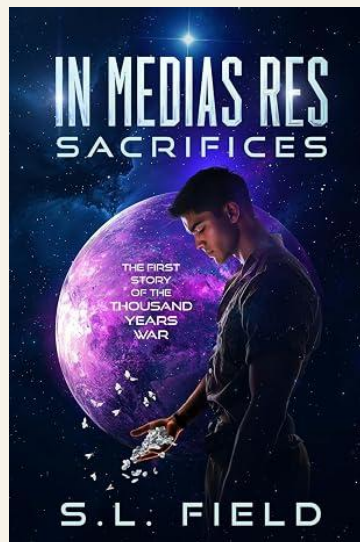




In Medias Res
