



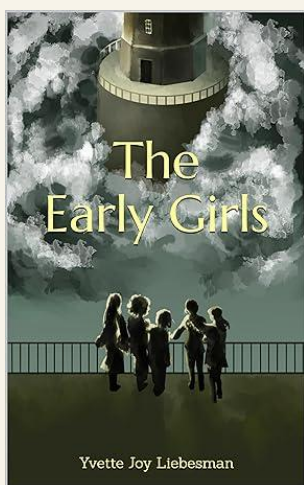
Yvette Joy Liebesman

In July 2025, she published "What is Claimed: A Patent Coloring Book." It is available in two paperback formats-- either single-sided and double-sided printing of the patent drawings.

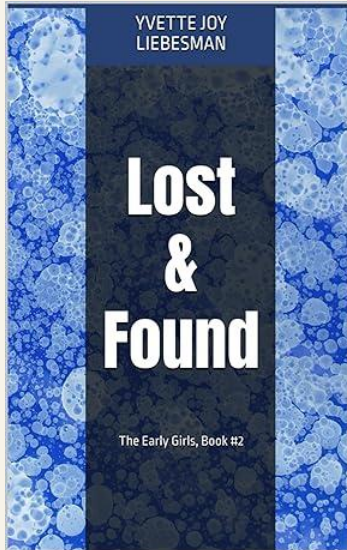

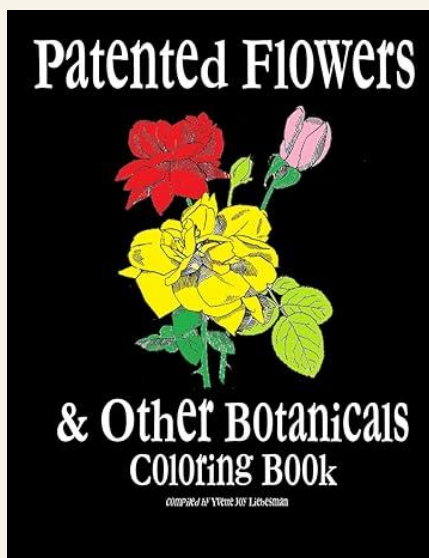

- Meanwhile, Rodney and Rick have parted ways, but their paths cross again in a sinister way.

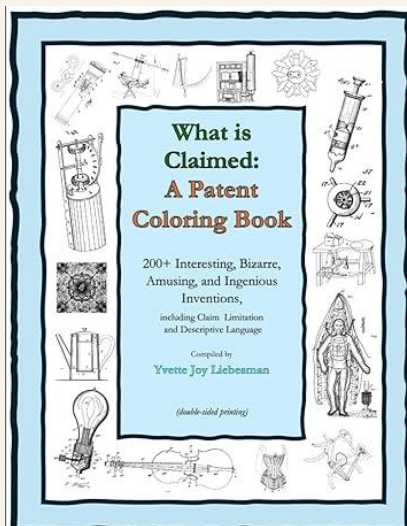

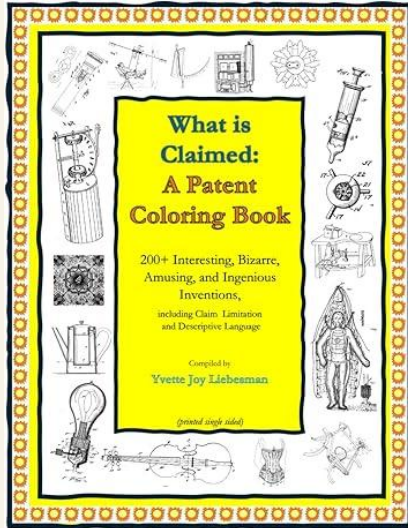
