



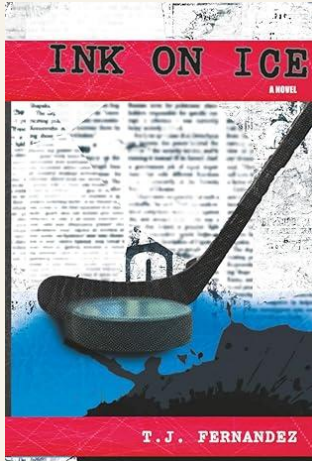
T J Fernandez
