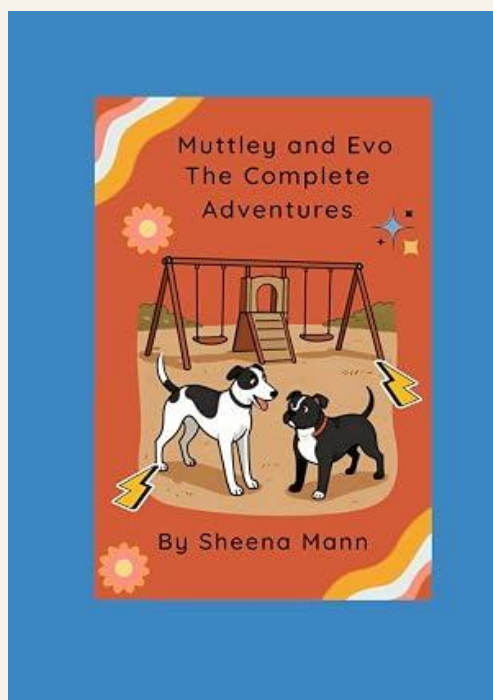




Muttley And Evo The Complete Adventures
