

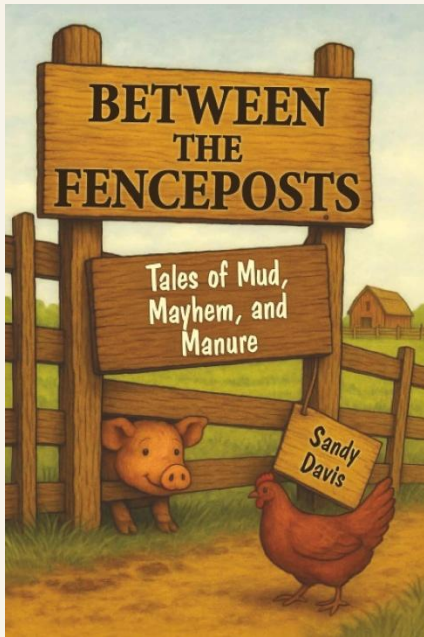


## Sandy Davis

Sandy Davis is a writer, homesteader, and storyteller from northern New Hampshire, where the locals recognize four seasons: almost winter, dead of winter, still winter, and three months of things that bite. Her writing blends humour, heart, and the everyday realities of rural life, from chickens with opinions on everything to sheep, goats, livestock guardian dogs, and the occasional disaster best appreciated in hindsight.

After careers in graphic design, photography, massage therapy, and years spent homesteading, Sandy began sharing stories from farm life on her blog and social media, where readers quickly connected with her warm, conversational storytelling style and honest humour about country living. She is the author of *Between the Fenceposts: Tales of Mud, Mayhem, and Manure*, a collection of humorous and heartfelt true stories inspired by life on the farm. Her work has also appeared in homesteading and poultry publications.

A New Hampshire native, Sandy shares the farm with her husband, Jim. Together they raised seven children and now delight in twenty grandchildren and four great-grandchildren - mercifully not all visiting at once. Her stories, often sparked by mud, mayhem, and manure, reach beyond the farmyard to offer humour, resilience, and moments of quiet reflection from a life lived close to the land. *Between the Fenceposts* is both a gift to her family and proof that while good fences may not last forever, good stories just might.



## Between The Fenceposts

Life on a small farm is peaceful - until the goats test the fence, the chickens hold an emergency meeting about nothing, and the sheep hear a grain scoop from distances that defy science and common sense.

In *Between the Fenceposts*, Sandy Davis invites readers into her North Country New Hampshire farm, where plans are optimistic, dignity is short-lived, and chaos shows up daily without so much as a courtesy call. Told in a series of short, laugh-out-loud essays, these true stories chronicle escaped livestock, questionable animal logic, and the stubborn human belief that *this time* everything will go smoothly.

Between the mud, mayhem, and manure are quieter, heartfelt moments that linger. Sandy also writes about family, resilience, and the small pauses that appear when the noise settles—moments of gratitude, reflection, and unexpected grace. The humour is sharp, but the heart runs deep.

This is not a farming manual or a glossy country fantasy. It's honest, affectionate storytelling for anyone who's ever watched a simple task unravel spectacularly and decided laughter was the only sensible response.

Perfect for readers who enjoy humorous memoirs, animal antics, and stories that balance comedy with meaning, *Between the Fenceposts* reminds us that fences fail, animals misbehave, and life rarely cooperates—but good stories, once earned, have a way of standing strong long after the fenceposts fall.
