**Marked by the Devil** (Micky the demon book 2)

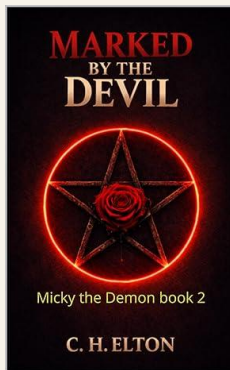
and there's always more poetry and stories waiting in the wings.

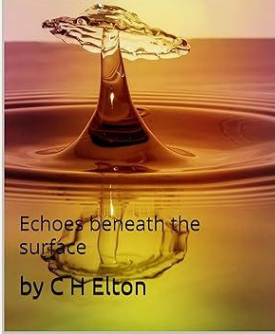


### **Reflections – Monologues And Muses Of Modern Times -**

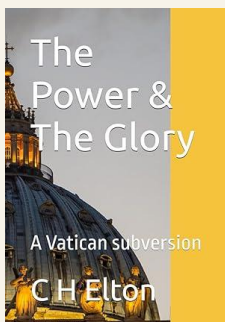
A parishioner who senses something changing in the man meant to guide the congregation.
