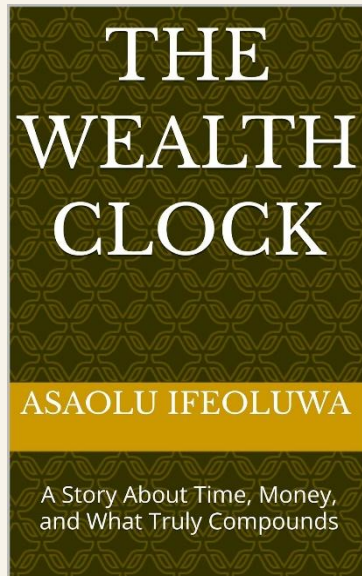




The Wealth Clock
